## Minutes Cass County Board of Supervisors Tuesday, December 3, 2024

The Cass County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the courthouse board room with members present: Steve Baier, chair; Stephen Green, Wendy Richter, Mark O'Brien and Bernard Pettinger. Absent: none.

Green moved, Pettinger second, to adopt the agenda as amended. All ayes. Motion carried.

O'Brien moved, Pettinger second, to approve the November 19, 2024 minutes. All ayes. Motion carried.

Public Comments: Megan Roberts welcomed Project Harmony to Cass County.

At 9:03 a.m., Baier recessed for the public hearing to consider application for zoning change by LANDUS Cooperative from General Agricultural District to Heavy Industrial District for property in Pymosa Township as approved by the Zoning Commission. Erich Wickman spoke in favor of the change. There were no comments in opposition. O'Brien moved, Richter seconded, to close the public hearing. All ayes. Motion carried. At 9:07 a.m., Baier closed the public hearing.

Green moved, Pettinger second, to approve the application for zoning change by LANDUS Cooperative from General Agricultural District to Heavy Industrial District for property in Pymosa Township. Ayes: Baier, Pettinger, Green, Richter, O'Brien. Nays: None. Motion carried.

O'Brien moved, Pettinger second, to approve Resolution 2024-28, Amending the Secondary Roads Five-Year Program, moving Project Number FM-CO15()—15, Bridge # 132 15626 from 2027 to 2025. Ayes: Baier, Pettinger, Green, Richter, O'Brien. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Trent Wolken, County Engineer, reviewed current road and equipment projects.

Pettinger moved, Green second, to approve the hire of Anita District Equipment Operator 1 in accordance with the Employee Agreement rate schedule. All ayes. Motion carried.

Ryan Berven, with Assured Partners, presented the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 employee benefit renewal rates. Following Iowa State Association of Counties' (ISAC) best year in the history of the pool, the health insurance base rate will decrease three percent. Dental insurance will increase 2%, vision insurance will increase 3%, life, accident and critical illness rates are expected to remain about the same.

Green moved, O'Brien second, to approve the second reading of Ordinance Number 39, Imposing a Local Option Income Surtax for Emergency Medical Services at a rate of one percent on the state individual income tax for 15 years in accordance with Iowa Code 422D following the November 5, 2024 General Election when Public Measure A was approved by more than 60% of those voting on the question. Ayes: Baier, Green, Richter, O'Brien, Pettinger. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Pettinger moved, Green second, to acknowledge receipt of the EMS Advisory Council's Annual Recommendation of EMS Levy as required by Iowa Code 422D. All ayes. Motion carried.

O'Brien moved, Richter second, to approve the hire of Treasurer's Office Assistant effective December 2, 2024. All ayes. Motion carried.

Debbie Schuler, Cass County Mental Health & General Relief Coordinator, presented the October and November monthly reports.
